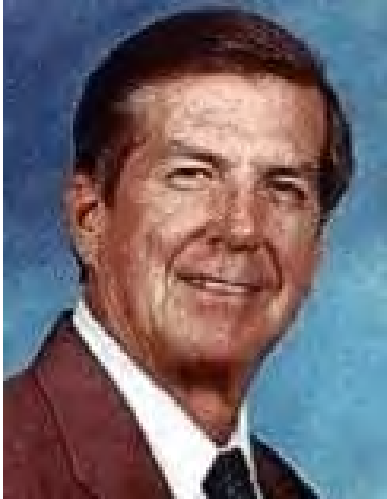

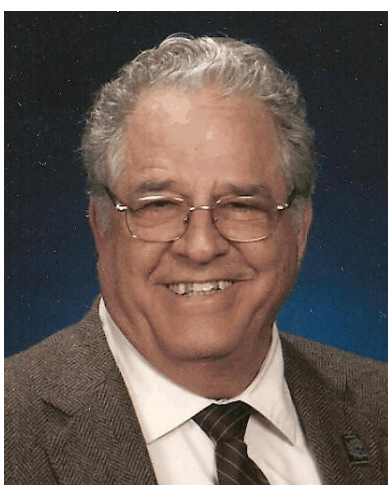


George Anderson

wife, Laurie, have three daughters and one grandson.

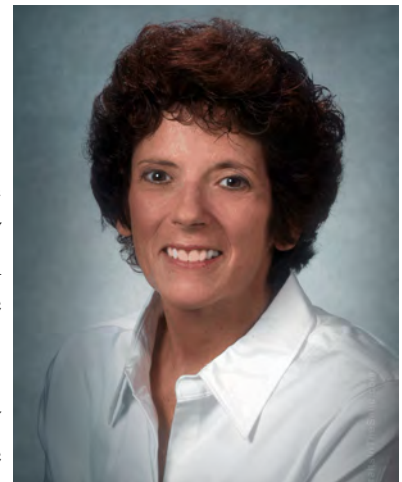
Judy Friis

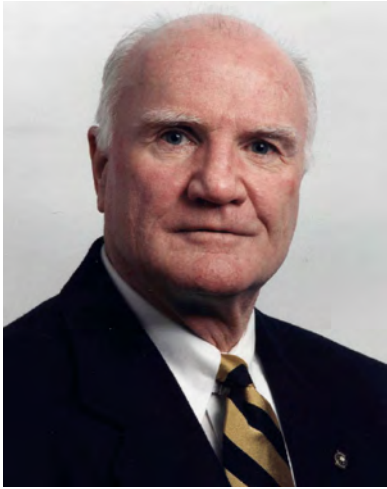
Scott Mills

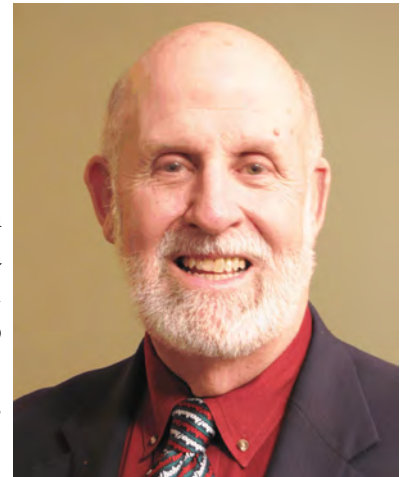


Joe Mulkerrin
