Beyond the club level, he served as a Rotary Foundation Advocate, Assistant Governor, District Membership Chair, Extension Committee Chair (starting new Rotary clubs), before becoming District Governor. Stephen helped to charter two new Rotary clubs in District 7600. He has also been District 7600's International Service Chair, District Rotary Foundation Committee Chair, District Trainer, and District PETS Trainer. Stephen was his district's representative to the Council on Resolutions and Council on Legislation and served on the Zone 33 nominating committee to select our next RI Director. Currently, Stephen is also an Assistant Regional Rotary Foundation Coordinator for Rotary Zone 33, assisting and advising Rotary leaders regarding our Rotary Foundation.

Passionate about training, Stephen served for several years as a Rotary Leadership Institute (RLI) Discussion Leader and served in different roles for Chesapeake PETS since its inception.

Stephen's favorite part of Rotary International is the "International" part of Rotary as evidenced by his involvement in overseas projects in Honduras, the Philippines and Ghana. One of Stephen's most memorable experiences was participating in a polio National Immunization Day in India. He was also the Team Leader for a Group Study Exchange to District 1850 in Germany and has led or participated in Friendship Exchanges to/from Germany and the Philippines.

Stephen supports The Rotary Foundation. He is a member of the Arch Klumph Society and Bequest Society. He has seen the incredible impact our Foundation has made to improve the lives of disadvantaged people locally and around the world.
